As part of its new technology ownership announcement above, Itheon are pleased to announce that the next release of iAM:Consoles has passed through our rigorous internal QA testing procedures and we are actively seeking customers interested in Beta testing this version in the field.

The most significant addition in the latest version is the provision of SSH support allowing even more secure access to system consoles. There are also various bug fixes and minor enhancements such as allowing secondary match strings and an increase in the number of user defined key sequences when using telnet.
